- Notify NTFB of any media coverage related to Partner Garden donations and NTFB partnership activities.
- Garden site visit with NTFB staff member when first joining program and on an as-needed basis

North Texas Food Bank will provide:

- Garden resources, as available from donations or funding
- Free visibility on the NTFB website.
- Annual Partner Garden Manager event
- NTFB Garden Coordinator as free garden resource for questions and assistance
