

FEEDING NORTH TEXAS DURING COVID-19

Since the onset of the COVID-19 pandemic, the North Texas Food Bank team has worked tirelessly to provide healthy food to neighbors in need. Many of our neighbors have seen their budgets stretched to the max. Thanks to the support of a generous community, NTFB has been able to double our food output to help feed our community. The information below represents the work of the NTFB from March 20, 2020, thru the end of January 2021.



40% of the people served by the Food Bank Feeding Network were new clients



134,000+ households served via 354 Pandemic Mobile Pantry Distributions



94% of the food distributed was nutritious



\$64.8 million in COVID-related costs



105 million+ pounds distributed (a 77% increase*)



22 million+ SNAP meals



\$25.6 million in Government support as well as manpower from the National Guard



110 million+ meals provided (a 47% increase*)
