Founded in 1982, the North Texas Food Bank is our region's largest provider of food assistance to neighbors in need. The organization provides access to nearly 137 million nutritious meals annually through a network of more than 400 feeding partners across a 13-county service area. This year, our goals are to:

- Raise \$50,000, equal to 150,000 meals
- Collect 1,000 pounds of food
- Register 300 volunteer hours at NTFB
