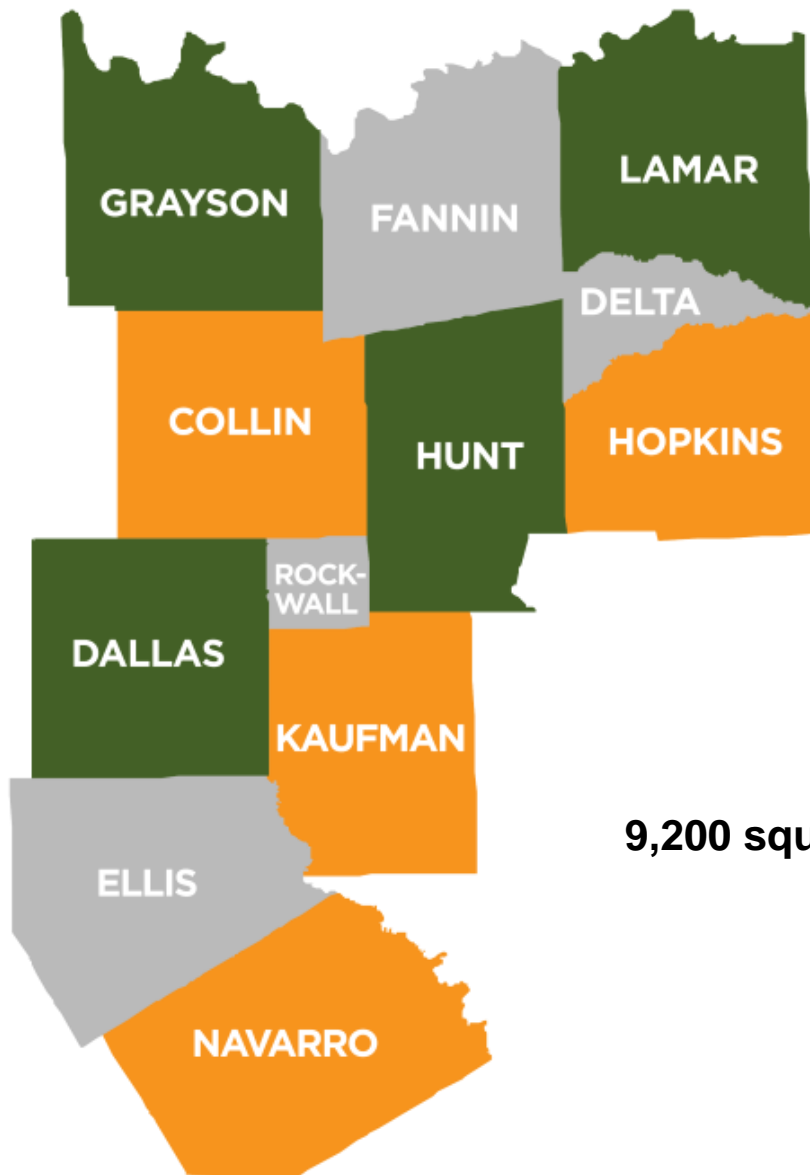


# North Texas Food Bank 12-County Service Area

# Food Insecurity in North Texas

## NTFB Service Area – 12 Counties

- 663,510 individuals are food insecure (1 in 7 people).
- 663,510 food-insecure individuals (1 in 7 people), 8th highest in the Feeding America network.
- 14.6% of the population is food insecure.
- Dallas County has the 6th highest number in the U.S., accounting for 60% of the area's food insecurity.
- Collin County represents 20%, with the remaining 20% spread across 10 counties.
- 252,540 food-insecure children (nearly 40% of the total).
